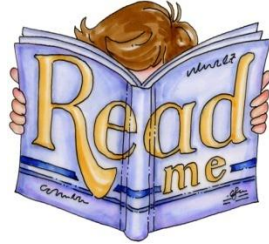
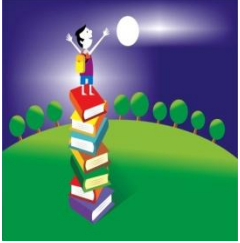


Books...Boring? NEVER!!
