### **Nevada Partners:**

Work Readiness Workshops, Career Club, Career Development, Training Referrals, Program Interview & Skills Assessment, Career Counseling/Workforce Development, Employment Support, Career Center, Financial Literacy, Youth Program Services, Family Academy.

**Catholic Charities Employment Service Center:** Employment Services Center offers help to men and women 18 years or older with job skills assessment and employment. Services include: job placement, employment/career counseling, onsite job interviews, resumes, referral computer training center.

**Social Security:** Social Security Disability, Employment Opportunities.

**Rebuilding All Goals Effectively (RAGE):** Community based employment opportunities.

**Clark County Fire Department Explorer:** The purpose of the explorer program is to expose young men and women to the fire service so they may decide if this is a career for them to pursue. This is accomplished by teaching these individuals firefighting techniques, EMS, proper uniform and personal codes of conduct; furthermore, by allowing these individuals to complete ride-alongs with fire crews and participate in live practical exercises.

**State of Nevada, Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation:** The Department of Employment, Training & Rehabilitation consists of divisions that offer assistance in job training and placement, vocational rehabilitation, workplace discrimination and in collecting and analyzing workforce and economic data. Many of these services are provided through DETR's partnership with the Nevada Job Connect system.

**UNLV Disability Resource Center:** Accommodations for people with disabilities attending a college setting.

**Army Recruiter:** Armed Forces, training, education and career.

**Foundation for Independent Tomorrow (Fit):** Career training & employment.

**College of Southern Nevada (CSN) Union Apprenticeship Program:** Training through partnerships with local trade unions. Apprenticeship programs available: Asbestos, Bricklayers & Tile Setters, Carpenters, Cement Mason/Plasters, Electrical, Glaziers, Ironworkers, Operating Engineers, Plumbers and Pipe Fitters, Sheet Metal Works, Laborers, Painters, Roofers.
