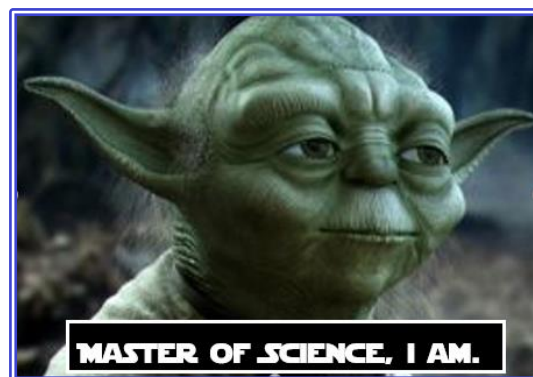
SCIENCE TEACHING ALWAYS ROCKS
