

"Walking In My Purpose" Sustaining Book Scholarship

Who May Apply:

Current active Member of their school site Black Student Union Club in the BSU Network, with a minimum two years consecutive active membership in good standing; a graduating senior who will be attending in the fall an accredited college, university, vocational or trade/technical school; or who is currently enrolled as a freshman in an accredited college, university, vocational or trade/technical school and met the above criteria in their high school senior year.

Must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.7 unweighted

APPLICATION PACKAGE:

- 1. Application Cover Sheet
- 2. High School Transcript
- 3. Certification and Authorization form
- 4. College Acceptance Letter
- 5. Two (2) Letters of Recommendations: One from a school official (administrator, counselor, teacher, BSU club advisor) on school letterhead, and one from an adult mentor (community leader, clergy, employer, after school program leader, etc.)
- 6. 350-500 Word Essay (must be typed) on the topic: As a member of the BSU Network, how has the experience impacted your life? (*Give examples, how have you grown, skills learned, goals set, etc. Include any leadership roles as an officer in your BSU Club and how that experience impacted you.*)

AWARDS

\$2,500 Sustaining Book Scholarship awarded in \$625 increments each year over 4 consecutive years, pending verification of continued eligibility and met prior to disbursement. Funds will be disbursed directly to the college, university or trade/technical school bookstore as a school credit to the student account.
