The initiative behind the Angels Wings Thai Scholarship is to recognize and honor Thai American students who have demonstrated academic excellence, concern for their Thai community, heritage connection and desire to continue their education. The required factors may be demonstrated through participation in community, high school/college and advocacy activities.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants for the Angels Wings Thai Scholarship must:

- Live anywhere in the US
- Be a graduating high school senior
- Be entering an accredited college, university or trade school for the 2026-2027 school year
- Have an unweighted cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better
- Demonstrate your aspiration through a 500-1000 word Essay:

What motivated you to pursue your major, and how do you envision it shaping your career and future opportunities?

How has being Thai and growing up in a multicultural society shaped your identity?

What is your favorite movie or book, and what lessons or inspiration have you gained from it?
