SEPTEMBER SCHOLARSHIP NEWSLETTER

DEADLINES BETWEEN: September 29, 2026 & December 31, 2026

1) Owl Scholarship - \$50,000 - 50 Awards (Deadline: September 29, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories.
- B) Be 16 years of age or older and be enrolled in college or registered in a high school.

2) Coca-Cola Scholars Program - \$20,000 - 150 Awards (Deadline: September 30, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a current high school student who will graduate during the 2026-2027 school year.
- B) Be a US Citizens, US National, Permanent Resident, Refugee, Asylee, or be of Cuban-Haitian decent.

3) Be Bold Scholarship - \$25,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: September 30, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Plan on enrolling in college by the fall of 2026 or 2027.
- B) Have a GPA of at least 2.5.

4) Path to Pro Scholarship Program - \$2,500 - 125 Awards (Deadline: September 30, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior, high school graduate or have a GED equivalent.
- B) Plan to enroll, or be enrolled within 1 year, in an approved trade-related program at an accredited two-year school or institution (i.e. technical/vocational school, community college or training center) in the United States.

5) SM Scholarship - \$2,000 - 12 Awards (Deadline: September 30, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a student who is currently enrolled as a high school junior or senior.
- B) Be a student who intends to enroll in an accredited college or university located within the United States.

6) Scholarships360 No Essay Scholarship - \$10,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: September 30, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled, or planning to be enrolled, in a U.S. college or university in the Fall of 2026 or 2027.
- B) Be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories.

7) Epic Flight Academy Aviation Scholarships - \$20,000 - 16 Award (Deadline: October 1, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to enter a career in the aviation industry as a pilot or a mechanic.
- B) Be currently attending high school in the United States.

8) Niche Scholarship - \$40,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: October 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a senior in high school or a current college student.
- B) Be attending or planning to attend college, university, or professional training school in the Fall of 2027.

9) P.E.O. STAR Scholarship - \$2,500 – 100 Awards (Deadline: October 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a female high school senior.
- B) Have a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

10) 10 Words or Less Scholarship - \$1,500 – 2 Awards (Deadline: November 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be between the ages of 17-25.
- B) Be attending college or university in the Fall of 2027.

11) Common App Scholarship - \$2,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: December 15, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be in Grade 11 or Grade 12.
- B) Have achieved a GPA of 2.5 or greater during their last academic year.

12) Arthur M. & Berdena King Eagle Scout Scholarship - \$10,000 – 15 Awards (Deadline: Dec. 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior that plans on attending college or university in the Fall of 2027.
- B) Be an Eagle Scout who is registered in an active unit and has not reached their nineteenth birthday.

13) Science Buddy Scholarship - \$2,750 - 5 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be in Grade 11 or Grade 12 and be attending college or university no later than September 15, 2027.
- B) Be entering, or currently pursuing, an educational program in the sciences.

14) Healthcare Leaders Scholarship - \$1,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be entering, or currently pursuing, an educational program related to nursing or medicine.
- B) Be at least 17 years old with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

15) Future Travel Nurse Scholarship - \$1,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2026)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) Have been accepted to a nursing program at an accredited institution in the United States.
